TASK	HAZARDS	CONTROLS
1. Select appropriate stock to be manipulated.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Uneven, non-durable, or brittle stock may shatter and fling debris or entrap the user. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Hands on training and requiring shop instructor to provide guidance on the stock that is to be used by the student.
2. Position material on table.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pinching of fingers and or hands. - Oscillating Blade. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Keep hands and fingers clear of blade when cutting material.
3. Adjust Blade guard to proper height for material.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Damage to the equipment and or user if not set correctly. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use hand guards.
4. Set speed for material.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Body injury and or damage to work piece.
